Students who are US citizens and enrolled as full- or part-time students in a degree granting program are eligible to apply for the diversity grants. Benefit-eligible HBFF employees and any student enrolled in fewer than five credits are not eligible. Applicant names will be redacted, and essays will be rated by Graduate School alumni. Please check the box next to the grant(s) for which you are applying. *Essay format is required.*

Alan Braun LGBT Grant: This grant is available to students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender. The student(s) selected for this award remains confidential. Award amounts will be determined by financial need and available funds, up to a maximum award of \$1500 per student. Students may only receive one A.B. LGBT Grant while enrolled at the Graduate School. To apply, students must submit an essay of no more than 500 words that includes:

1. Self-identification as a member of the LGBT community.
2. An explanation of how the student has provided service and/or support to the LGBT recovery community and/or the LGBT community as a whole.
3. Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

LGBT Grant: This grant is available to students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender. One or more students will be selected for this award each semester, and identity remains confidential. Award amounts will be determined by available funds, up to a maximum award of \$1,000 per student. Students may only receive one LGBT Grant while enrolled at the Graduate School. To apply, students must submit an essay of no more than 500 words that includes:

1. Self-identification as a member of the LGBT community.
2. A scholarly discussion of an issue of the student's choice that affects the LGBT community.

Minority Grant: This grant is available to students who identify as African American, Native American, Asian American, Alaska Native or Latino American. One or more students will be selected for this award each semester. The maximum award is approximately \$1,000 per student. Students may only receive one Minority Grant while enrolled at the Graduate School. To apply, students must submit an essay of no more than 500 words that includes:

1. Self-identification as a member of one of the following minority groups: African American, Native American, Asian American, Alaska Native or Latino American.
2. An explanation of how the student has provided service and/or support to the minority recovery community and/or the minority community as a whole.
