2. Essay- The essay should also address why you are applying for the Hope Scholarship, your commitment to and experience in the field of addiction counseling, and/or why you are deserving of the Hope Scholarship. Your essay should be double spaced with 12-point font and not exceed two (2) pages.
3. Resume-Please provide a resume which details your education, work experience, credentials,

and accomplishments to date.
