## Town & Country Club Guidelines

### ATTIRE

Persons using the golf course must be properly attired and utilize appropriate footwear. Town & Country Club is a soft spike only facility. The following articles of clothing are not considered appropriate and are not permitted: Cut-offs, Mesh Shirts, Swim Wear, Tennis Wear, Tank Tops, Short Shorts, Halter Top, Gym Shorts, Jeans of any color, Cargo Shorts and Tee Shirts. All headwear must be worn appropriately.

### GOLF CARTS

When using a motorized golf cart:

- Use and stay on paths whenever possible.
- Keep carts away from all tees and greens.
- Do not drive carts between bunkers and greens.
- Always use parking brake.
- Respect all signs and ropes.
- Avoid wet grass.
- Children under age of 16 are not allowed to drive carts.

### **COURSE ETIQUETTE**

On the course, all players must:

- Replace ball marks
- Replace and step down divots
- Rake bunkers smooth after use

### **CELL PHONES**

Please have your cell phones turned off, or on silent, on the golf course. Cell phones are not allowed in any of the dining areas of the clubhouse, except the Card Room.
