This scholarship is available to students who identify as gay, lesbian, bisexual, or transgender. Identity will remain confidential as names are redacted during the scholarship review process. Students admitted to and seeking a degree at the Hazelden Betty Ford Graduate School of Addiction Studies may apply for the Dr. Andrew Jeon Graduate School GLBT Scholarship which awards recipients \$10,000 scholarship funds to be distributed over two semesters. International students and benefit-eligible Hazelden Betty Ford employees are not eligible to apply. Students previously selected are not eligible for future consideration. Students are not eligible to receive any additional HBFGSAS scholarships nor grants during the terms receiving the Dr. Andrew Jeon Scholarship.

3. Submit a double-spaced essay of no more than 500 words which includes:
 - a. Self-identification as a member of the GLBT community.
 - b. How will the scholarship advance your career goals as an addiction counselor?
