Students are not eligible to receive any additional HBFSGSAS scholarships nor grants during the terms receiving the Dr. Tim & Mary Sheehan Scholarship for Students of Color.

1. Confirmed admission and summer course registration at the Hazelden Betty Ford Graduate School of Addiction Studies.
2. Dr. Tim & Mary Sheehan Scholarship for Students of Color Scholarship Application form- Please make sure to complete and sign this form.
3. Essay- The essay should address why you are applying for the Dr. Tim & Mary Sheehan Scholarship for Students of Color, your commitment to and experience in the field of addiction counseling, and/or why you are deserving of the Dr. Tim & Mary Sheehan Scholarship for Students of Color. Your essay should be double spaced with 12-point font and not exceed two (2) pages.
4. Resume-Please provide a resume which details your education, work experience, credentials, and accomplishments to date.
5. Complete [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](https://fafsa.ed.gov/) (FAFSA) at <https://fafsa.ed.gov/>. Scholarship applicants will only be considered if Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) is 50,000 or less.
