Recovery coaching, accountability verification reports and drug testing are key components of Connection. This intensive level of recovery support and monitoring has proven to be especially helpful for individuals who've been in treatment multiple times, those facing loss of a professional license, those struggling with legal issues or custody matters, students returning to college or anyone needing additional accountability.

Through Connection services, family members and other key stakeholders designated by you—such as your employer, licensing board, school administrator or probation officer—stay informed and involved in your recovery, too.

Services include:

- Recovery coaching and case management
- Frequent phone contact with you and your designated family members
- Documented recovery updates
- Random drug testing for accountability

Connection for Families™

This program offers support, education and guidance for families—no matter where their loved one is at in their recovery journey.

Services include:

- Phone coaching sessions with a recovery coach (licensed alcohol and drug counselor)
- Six 30-minute calls with a recovery coach
